## Meet the cats

Erica Kutzing, Save-A-Pet director of operations, is bringing five feline friends to Chase Bank on Main Street in Port Jefferson this weekend, Aug. 4-5, in an effort to get the animals adopted.

The cats were recently rescued from the property of a condemned house on Oakwood Road in Port Jefferson and need loving homes. Three are domestic

short-haired cats — 7-year-old Rico Suave, 2-year-old Murphy and 6-year-old Nigel — and two are domestic long-haired cats — 15-year-old Pinky and 6-month-old Tweek. All five of these critters have received their vaccinations and been spayed or neutered and are good around other cats.

Prospective owners can meet the cats at the bank between noon and 4 pm.
